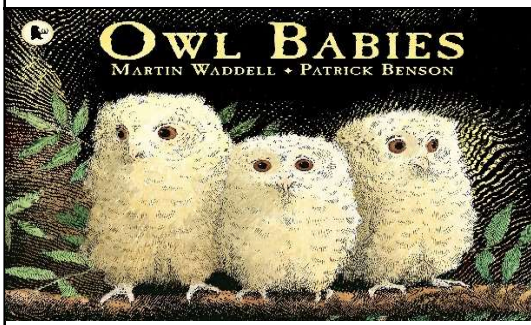
Here are some ideas to try at home.
