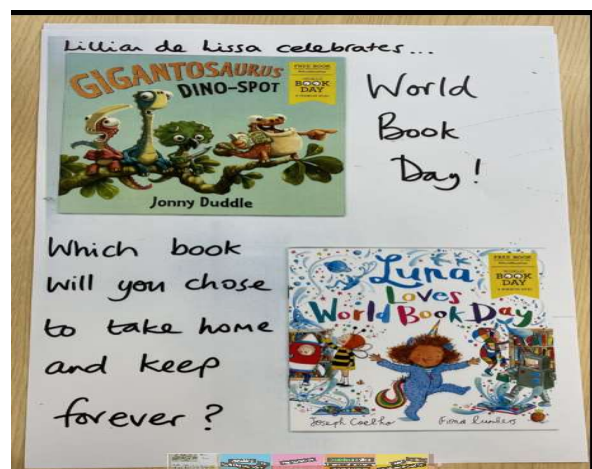
Hello everyone!

As part of the celebration we can give you a FREE BOOK to keep.

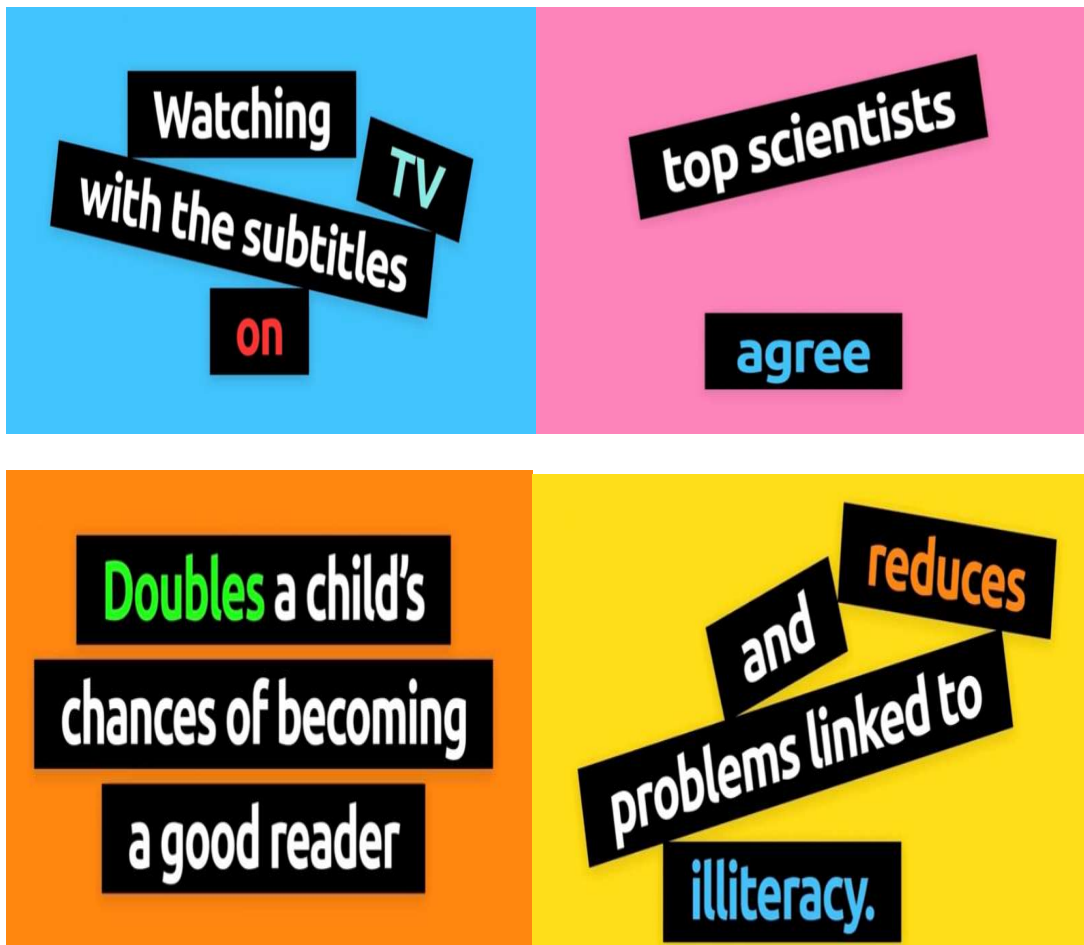
Your child can chose from Gigantosaurus Dinospot or Luna Loves World Book Day.
