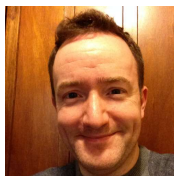


# Nursery News Letter June 2023

## Morning and End of Day Routines

We enjoy welcoming our parents into our classroom environment as we are able to have such lovely chats with you. Please could we ask that you do your best to arrive on time to Nursery. This is because group time starts at 9.15am prompt.

If you arrive after 9.15am you will need to use the side gate entrance.

There are two options for collection time. 2.25pm prompt is the early collection time.

Then we have story time sessions at nursery from 2.30pm until 2.50pm. The main collection time is 2.50pm. Thank you for your continued understanding and support.

## School Places

If your child is attending school in September 2023 you should have received a school offer by now. Please remember to let your key worker know which school they have been accepted at. This is so we can arrange important transition meetings with your child's new school.

## Dinner Money and School Fund

Please pay dinner money, school fees and school fund in advance to David in the office.

Dinner money is £2.20 a day. Please also remember to pay school fund as this buys the lovely extras for our children. £1 per week for part time children £2 per week for full time children.

## Attendance Matters

We understand that children are unwell sometimes but it is also important for us to promote excellent attendance at nursery.

The reasons for children to attend regularly at their early years setting are to support their learning and development and to make sure that children are kept safe. It is also important that their wellbeing is promoted and they do not miss out on their entitlements and opportunities.

Children who have achieved 80% or above for their attendance will be awarded a certificate at the end of the summer term. Well done to everyone who has received an excellent attendance certificate so far!
